200 new members join us, use our canoes and kayaks for free and strengthen the river community.

1st mainstem dam removed in NE Massachusetts and...

56 miles of river freed when the South Middleton dam comes down this year, after three years of planning and studies.

100 paddlers in inaugural paddleathon to build awareness, raise funds, and have fun together.

800 culverts and bridges surveyed for their risk of failure during large rain storms and their impact on wildlife.

500 kids get fit on the river and experience the joy of nature.

300 acres of shellfish beds reopened when we control a pollution source to make the Ipswich River shellfish beds safe for harvesting.

100 million gallons of water saved if we work together to reduce water use in the watershed by only 1%.
