

Materials: Scotch tape. Duct tape. Glue. Scissors. Three sheets 8.5x11 scrap printer paper (or any heavy paper). Two sticks (about 14" & 24"). For decorating: Paint, markers, fabric or paper scraps, leaves, upcycled foil/shiny wrappers.

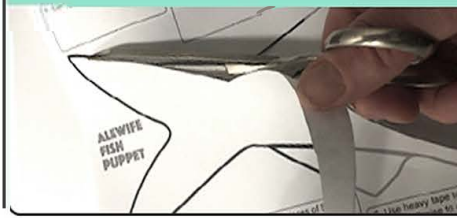
1. Cut out the fish head



2. Glue fish head to one half of 8.5x11 scrap paper



3. Cut out the fish body



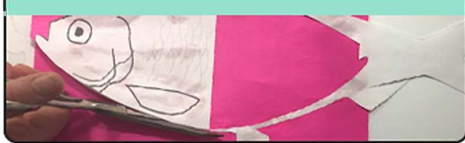
ALEWIFE FISH PUPPET

4. Line up fish body with fish head. Glue and cut out



5. Tape two pieces of 8.5x11 scrap together. Trace fish & cut



6. Use duct tape over 14" stick on one side of fish, lengthwise



7. Tape 24" stick to fish. Overlap sticks 2". Extra tape over joint



8. Glue and tape both sides of fish together, over stick handle



9. Decorate!
